RELAY FOR LIFE

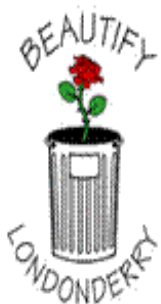

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

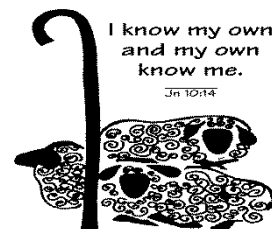

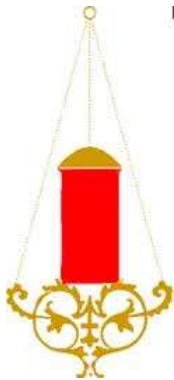
RETROUVAILLE... A LIFELINE FOR MARRIAGE

READINGS FOR THE WEEK

APRIL 26, 2015

First Reading: Acts 4:8-12

Here Peter speaks out bravely to the Sanhedrin, having been “taught” by the Holy Spirit. At the same time, his discourse is an act of faith in the crucified and risen Jesus.

Second Reading: I John 3:1-2

Being a child of God means not belonging to this world or accepting its values. It also implies a greater salvation for God’s true children in the next life.

Gospel: John 10:11-18

“Good” here means more than “good at”. It means that Jesus is a “good shepherd” in the sense of His being an “ideal” or “noble” one. He is that shepherd who out of love for His heavenly Father and a similar love for His sheep, goes to death in perfect obedience. That love connection is eternal
