### SINGLE AGAIN AND ANNULMENTS

Sometimes life does not play out as expected. However, through the healing process of the separated, divorced, and widowed we can witness God's love. Through the invalidity process, the divorced can experience God's healing love. We want to help you through that process and serve as a resource for any questions you may have. The first step is to contact your Parish Priest, Deacon, or Pastoral Associate to make an appointment to complete a Petition for the Declaration of an Invalid Marriage. This can only be done upon completion of a civil divorce. All parishes in the diocese are supplied with petitions. Be sure to provide complete documentation and accurate information while filling out the petition. The judges have the right to reject a petition if there does not appear to be any grounds, or if an investigation does not appear to be warranted by the petitioner's statements.

**REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK**

**July 05, 2015**

**First Reading: Ezekiel 2:2-5**

God charges Ezekiel with the task of proclaiming the divine message to a stubbornly disobedient people who have opposed him from the start.

**Second Reading: II Corinthians 2:7-10**

Paul suffers from a "thorn in the flesh", which can be interpreted as a physical handicap, but is more likely an ongoing hostility toward him from within his communities. His acceptance of this and his weaknesses give witness to the power of God that enables him to minister.

**Gospel: Mark 6:1-6a**

Jesus meets head on the hometown prejudice against a local person who achieves celebrity. Incidentally, the crowd calling Jesus "the son of Mary" was an added insult at a time when sons were known by their fathers. Jesus is stymied by their lack of faith.
