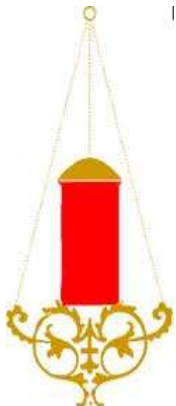
### ROOTS/ROUTES OF FAITH FOLLOWING IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF /SAINT PAUL
