## St. Jude parish update

**Mass schedule:** Our schedule remains the same: Saturday 4 PM, Sunday 8 AM and 10 AM. Mass attendance is limited to about 40 people. Only the front entrance may be used to enter the church. Masks are required, and social distancing of 6 feet continues for every Mass. Distribution of Communion takes place at the end of Mass, and all attendees leave after they receive Communion.

Reminder: Bishop Libasci has reminded all NH Catholics that there is an ongoing dispensation during the Covid-19 pandemic.

St. Jude will continue to livestream the 10 AM Mass on Sundays. You do not need to be on Facebook to see the livestreams. Click on the link on our website, [www.stjudenh.com](http://www.stjudenh.com). Masses are also posted to our Facebook page after the livestream is complete.

If you are unable to attend Mass due to age or health concerns, but would like to receive Communion, you may park in the handicapped parking spaces along the church on the rectory side, and someone will bring the Eucharist to your car as soon as Mass attendees have all received. All those receiving in their cars should be wearing masks.

**Confessions** are on Saturdays at 3 PM or by appointment.

**Paving project:** Paving will take place October 12-16 – thanks be to God! There are no weekday Masses scheduled that week. The parking lot will be accessible on the weekend of October 17 & 18 for Masses.

**Church bulletins** are available at the church exits, and in the shrine. They are also available on our website, or you may sign up to have the bulletin emailed to you by our bulletin company. See the bulletin for details on signing up for email delivery.

**Missalettes** for Masses through November 28, 2020 are available at the church exits or in the shrine. Feel free to take one home if you would like one. You may bring it back and forth to church if you would like to use it for Mass, but you must take it home with you. Any left in the church will be discarded.
